Selective Micro Multi-Surface is an all-natural, bio-based, environmentally-friendly, multipurpose hard surface cleaner concentrate for industrial, household, institutional and restaurant use. It does not contain caustic detergents or petroleum-based solvents, so it will not damage the surfaces.

Suggested Concentrate Dilutions:

Light Cleaning	3-10%
Average Cleaning	10-20%
Difficult Cleaning	20-100%

Active Ingredients:

Surfactant Blend
Alkyl Polyglycoside

Instructions: Spray on and wipe clean. Selective Micro Multi-Surface may be used at full strength or diluted with water, depending on the application. Lower amounts of product may be used as needed based upon specific applications.

If in Eyes: Flush eyes with water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention if warranted.

Occupational Control Procedures:

Ventilation, respiratory, eye protection, skin protection – none required.

Storage: Store in a dry location away from heat, sparks and other sources of ignition, keep containers closed when not in use.

Spill and Leak Procedures: Spilled material may be slippery. Small spills can be washed into chemical sewers. Large spills should be collected for disposal. Dike area to contain spill. Absorbing sand, earth, vermiculite or similar material. Wear appropriate protective equipment.

Waste Disposal Methods: Incinerate or dispose of in approved solid waste disposal area per current regulations.
